1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that visited websites send to the user's device (computer, tablet, smartphone), where they are stored and then retransmitted to the same websites on the next visit. Cookies allow the website to function properly, to remember the user's preferences, and to collect statistical or profiling information.

2. Data Controller

3. Types of Cookies Used

Technical and necessary cookies. These are essential for the proper functioning of the website and to enable browsing and the use of services. They do not require the user's consent and cannot be disabled.

Analytical cookies. These allow statistical information to be collected, in aggregate form or otherwise, on the number of users and how they visit the website. They are used only with the user's consent.

Profiling and third-party cookies. These are used to track the user's browsing and to create profiles of their tastes, habits and choices, also for the purpose of sending advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed. They may be installed by third parties (e.g. social networks, analytics service providers). They are used only with the user's consent.

4. Consent Management

On first access to the website, a banner is displayed allowing the user to accept, refuse or customise the use of non-technical cookies. Consent management is handled by the Cookiebot platform, which pre-emptively blocks non-necessary cookies until the user gives consent and keeps a record of it.

The user may at any time modify or withdraw the preferences expressed by clicking on the relevant cookie management link or icon on the website.

5. Third-Party Cookies

The website may integrate content and services provided by third parties (for example social platforms such as Instagram, the Jotform booking form, or any analytics tools). Such parties may install their own cookies, for which reference is made to the respective privacy and cookie policies published on their websites.

6. How to Disable Cookies from the Browser

In addition to management via the banner, the user may disable cookies directly from their browser settings. The methods vary depending on the browser used (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, Microsoft Edge and others); please consult the browser's help section for specific instructions. Disabling technical cookies may impair the proper functioning of the website.

7. Rights of the Data Subject

The user may at any time exercise the rights provided for in Art. 15-22 of the GDPR (access, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, objection and withdrawal of consent) by writing to tiporto2026@gmail.com. The user also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (www.garanteprivacy.it).
