1. Data Controller

2. What Data We Collect

In managing bookings and enquiries, we process the following personal data that you provide voluntarily: full name, email address, telephone number, booking date and time, number of guests, and any preferences or special requests you communicate. We also collect browsing data through cookies, as described in our Cookie Policy.

3. Purposes and Legal Basis of Processing

Your data is processed for the following purposes: to manage and confirm your booking and provide the requested service (legal basis: performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures, Art. 6.1.b GDPR); to respond to your requests for information and contact (legal basis: legitimate interest or pre-contractual measures); to comply with legal, tax and accounting obligations where applicable (legal basis: legal obligation, Art. 6.1.c GDPR). Any promotional communications will be sent only with your explicit consent, which may be withdrawn at any time (Art. 6.1.a GDPR).

4. Processing Methods and Tools Used

Data is processed using electronic tools and with security measures adequate to prevent its loss, unlawful or unauthorised use. Bookings are collected through the Jotform service, a third-party provider acting as Data Processor. This service may involve the transfer of data to servers located outside the European Union (e.g. the United States); in such cases, the transfer takes place in compliance with the safeguards provided for in Art. 44 et seq. of the GDPR (Standard Contractual Clauses or equivalent mechanisms).

5. Disclosure and Dissemination of Data

Your data may be disclosed solely to parties providing services to us, appointed as Data Processors, including the booking platform provider (Jotform) and the website hosting provider (Hostinger International Ltd.), as well as any tax consultants, or to parties to whom disclosure is required by law. Your data is in no way disseminated or transferred to third parties for their own commercial purposes.

6. Data Retention Period

Booking data is retained for as long as necessary to provide the service and, thereafter, for the period required by legal obligations (in particular tax and accounting obligations, generally 10 years). Data

collected for contact purposes is retained for as long as necessary to handle the request. Data processed on the basis of consent is retained until consent is withdrawn.

7. Rights of the Data Subject

At any time you may exercise the rights provided for in Art. 15-22 of the GDPR: access to your data, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, portability, objection to processing, and withdrawal of consent (without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal).
